

MILITARY AND VETERANS LAW SECTION
Annual Meeting
November 15, 20156

The annual meeting of the Military and Veterans Law Section was called to order at 12:00 noon by the chair, David Kramer, at the Oregon State Bar, 16037 S.W. Upper Boones Ferry Road, Tigard, Oregon, on November 10, 2015, pursuant to notice.

Present were Chair David Kramer, Daniel Zene Crowe (chair elect), Mary Ellen Farr (secretary), Mark Holady (treasurer), executive committee member Paul Sundermier, Troy Wood (OSB liaison), Kerry Sharp (BOG liaison), and section members Jaimie Fender, Mark Exley, Doug MacEllven, Ross Neher, and Leslie Nelson. There is a balance of \$2,624 in the section's account as of October 31, 2016. He has prepared the long range plan and budget which he will provide to the Bar as required. The treasurer's report was unanimously approved.
